### CAMEO GUILD MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND BENEFITS

The Cameo Guild is a service organization of young women enrolled in tenth, eleventh and twelfth grades of high schools in Tuscaloosa County. Applications are accepted for the sophomore and junior year, and members are not required to reapply. Cameo Guild members serve as ambassadors for Historic Tuscaloosa, and host events for Historic Tuscaloosa, the Arts Council of West Alabama and Dickens Downtown.

Junior and Senior members are required to have a period-appropriate dress from the Regency, Victorian, Edwardian or Jazz Age. Sophomore members are not required to have period dress, but are welcome to participate in "dress" functions if they wish.

Dues for Cameo Guild are \$300.00. This amount is due by October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. We wish for all young women to be able to participate, regardless of financial situation. Partial and full scholarships are available via a confidential form.

Parents of Cameo Guild members enjoy membership in the Century Club of Historic Tuscaloosa. Century Club benefits include members-only events, provides for priority ticketing to other events and discounts for hosting events at Historic Tuscaloosa structures.

Members are required to have ten service hours per year. We keep our required hours manageable because Cameo members are involved in so many different activities. Most members finish the year with over thirty hours because our events are enjoyable and educational.

Cameo Guild membership promotes education in etiquette, the decorative arts, planning of events and social gatherings, public speaking and knowledge of Tuscaloosa's rich history.
