Covid-19 Efforts

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions that went into effect mid-March, we were unable to host our annual Easter Egg Hunt. Several tickets had already been sold for the event. With the permission of each ticket holder, we were able to donate all the proceeds from ticket sales to Kami Combs of the Tuscaloosa Barnyard, after learning what a struggle she was having maintaining the animals due to all the event cancellations, including ours.

While discussing ways that the Belles might participate in events with the residents at Capstone Village, the Activities Director shared that their residents were in need of protective masks, again as a result of Covid-19.
